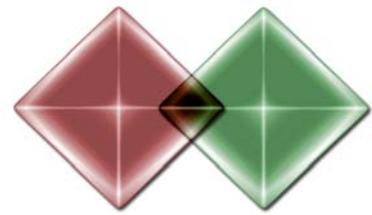


INTRODUCING THE 2007 PAWS & CLAWS AWARDS FOR CHARITY

Gold Coast will be the Host to the First Annual Paws & Claws Awards and will lead the way with this new, innovative and glamorous event.

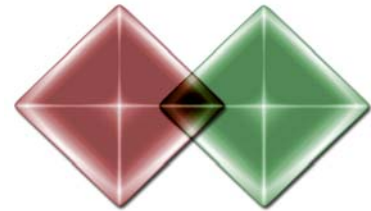

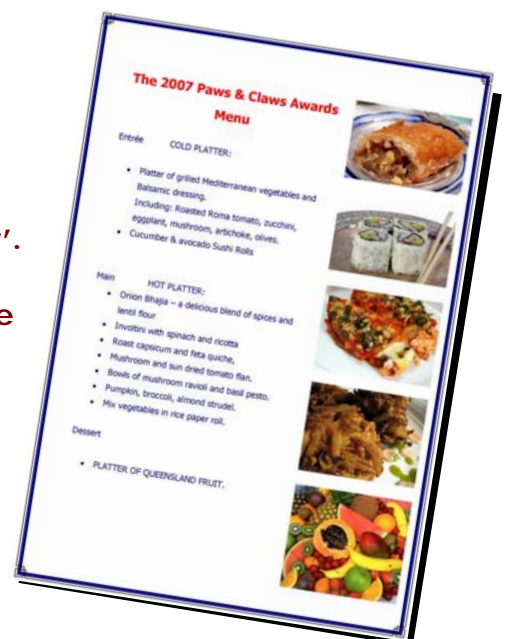

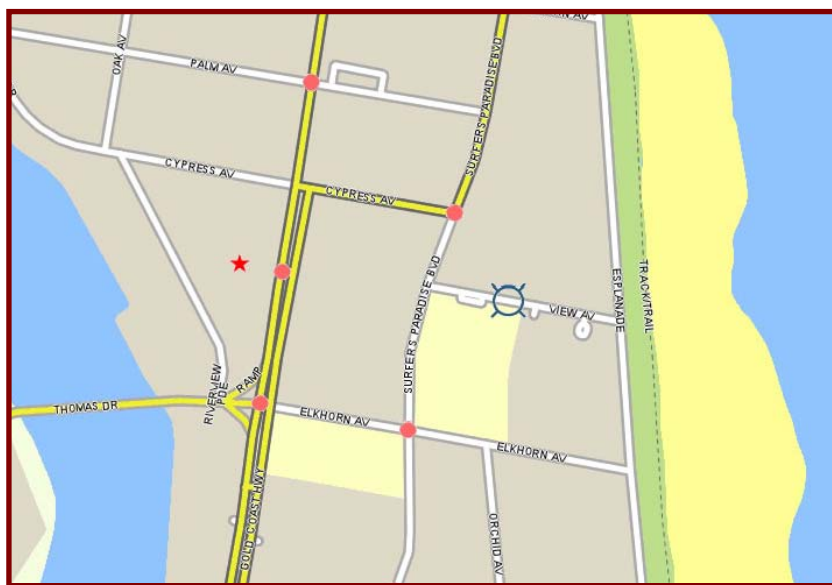

Terms & Conditions

Bookings

Bookings can be made by telephone, fax, email, post or via our website at www.pawsandclawsonline.com.au. Booking reservations without payment in full will be held on a provisional basis and places can not be guaranteed. All bookings are made on a first-come, first-served basis.

All fees must be paid in full no later than 4 weeks prior to the event, 28 days from invoice, or immediately for late bookings.

Once purchased, tickets cannot be exchanged, refunded or returned unless the event is cancelled or moved to another date.

By ordering you agree that the tickets are for the personal use of you and your party only, and will not be resold or transferred. Any resale or attempt to resell the tickets at a price higher than purchased will result in your orders being cancelled without prior notification.

If tickets that are despatched are returned to Arcadia Publishing Pty Ltd as "addressee unknown", we reserve the right to cancel the order.

In order to prevent fraud and to protect both parties, you may be asked to provide additional information after your booking so that we can verify your purchase.

Due to the nature of the event, the menu for the evening will be vegetarian. Please inform us of any special dietary requirements and we will endeavour to meet your needs.

Modifications
